



nce upon a time...

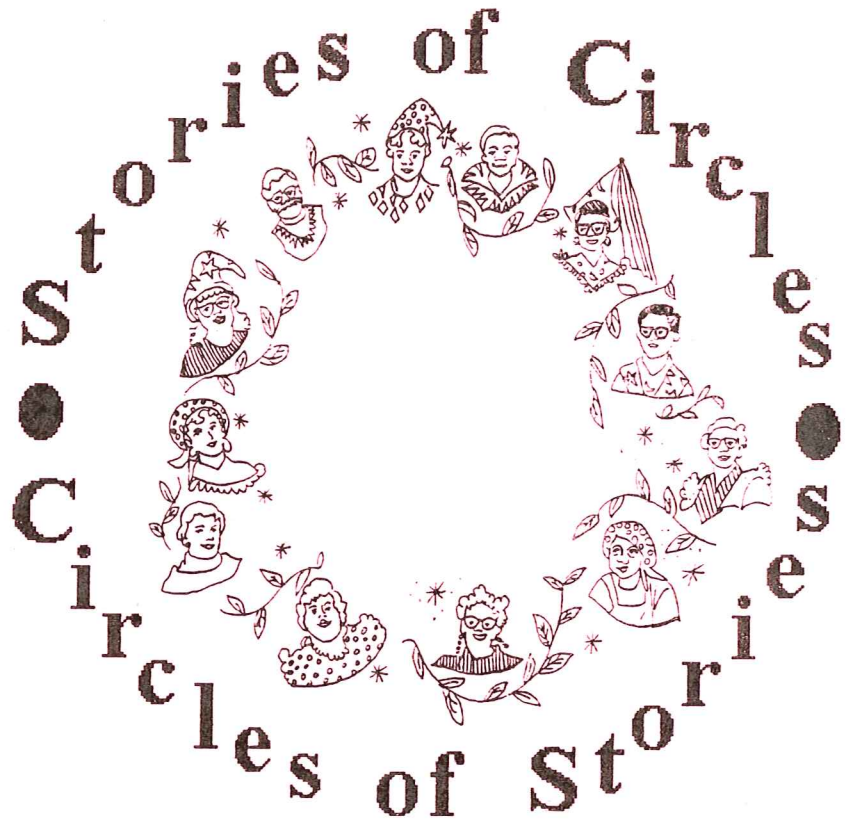
