Nominations Being Solicited for the 2000-01 Theodore Herfurth–Teddy Kubly Awards

Nominations for the 2000-01 Theodore Herfurth and Teddy Kubly Awards for Initiative and Efficiency are now being solicited from faculty members, university staff, and student organizations. The Theodore Herfurth Award is one of the oldest and most prestigious awards granted to senior students by the University of Wisconsin-Madison. The deadline for nominations is Friday 2 March 2001.

All outstanding undergraduates of the Madison campus with <u>86</u> or more credits (senior standing) are potentially eligible to compete. A committee, appointed by the chancellor, evaluates the nominees and selects the final recipients based upon the following four criteria: academic achievement, degree of self-support, significant contributions through extracurricular activities, and the ability to express oneself verbally. Each award recipient receives a cash prize as well as the significant honor of receiving one of the highest recognitions that a University of Wisconsin-Madison undergraduate student can receive.

Mr. Theodore Herfurth, a Madison insurance executive, first established this award for a senior man in 1928, and subsequently in 1943 provided a similar award for a senior woman. Mr. Herfurth's concern for the advancement and recognition of outstanding achievement among UW-Madison students is continued today by his daughter, Mrs. Harold Kubly. Male recipients receive the Theodore Herfurth Award; female recipients receive the Teddy Kubly Award.

The deadline for submitting the names of senior men and women as nominees for the Theodore Herfurth–Teddy Kubly Awards for Initiative and Efficiency is **Friday, 2 March 2001**.
